St Mark's offers the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP) to all students, from Preschool through to Year 8. The programme sees students exploring a series of transdisciplinary topics of global significance, strengthening their knowledge and understanding as they explore topical and relevant 'big picture' questions about the world around them. The aim is to inspire students to be caring, global citizens who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

The International Baccalaureate evaluation was held remotely, with two assessors from Auckland touring the school virtually with the aid of student guides who used a Chromebook to show the assessors around the learning environment. Parents, students, teachers and Board members were also interviewed via a Chromebook.

St Mark's School was particularly commended for promoting students' awareness of individual, local, national and world issues. The school was also commended for its strength in bringing together parents, staff and students in a very inclusive setting.
